

AccuRev Web Interface

Release Notes

(May 2008)

The AccuRev Web Interface (Web GUI) is a web application that runs on the Apache Tomcat application server. The Web GUI allows users to access data managed by the AccuRev Server via a Web browser.

Highlights of this Release

- Access to the Stream Browser, in both Graphical and Tabular Modes
- Access to the Annotate Tool
- Access to stream history
- New Stream dialog to create new dynamic, passthrough, and snapshot streams
- Absolute URLs for direct browser access to AccuRev-controlled elements
- Many UI and performance improvements

Known Issues in this Release

- Of the searches available in the File Browser, only the *Default Group* search is functional. The remaining searches will be available for use when the Web GUI is installed with AccuRev 4.6.2.
- (*Linux only*) The right-click menus available in the Web GUI are overlaid with the standard browser right-click menus. *Workaround:* Click once on the selected item to dismiss the browser menu and reveal the Web GUI menu.
- Due to Web GUI performance issues, we do not recommend using the History Browser to view the details of a transaction involving more than 1000 elements and versions.
- The URLs shown in the Properties dialog and the Diff Tool do not specify which AccuRev Server the element is on. If you attempt to access AccuRev elements directly via URL and your AccuRev installation includes more than one AccuRev Server (not including replicated servers), you will need to manually keep track of which server the element is on.
- When a session expires, the next time you attempt to access AccuRev data, the Web GUI will display a dialog indicating that you will have to log in again. The text of this dialog is misleading; you will need to click **Login** and enter your username and password to log in again.
