- Ease of use, agility, high performance, and process flexibility to easily accommodate multiple processes and organizational changes.

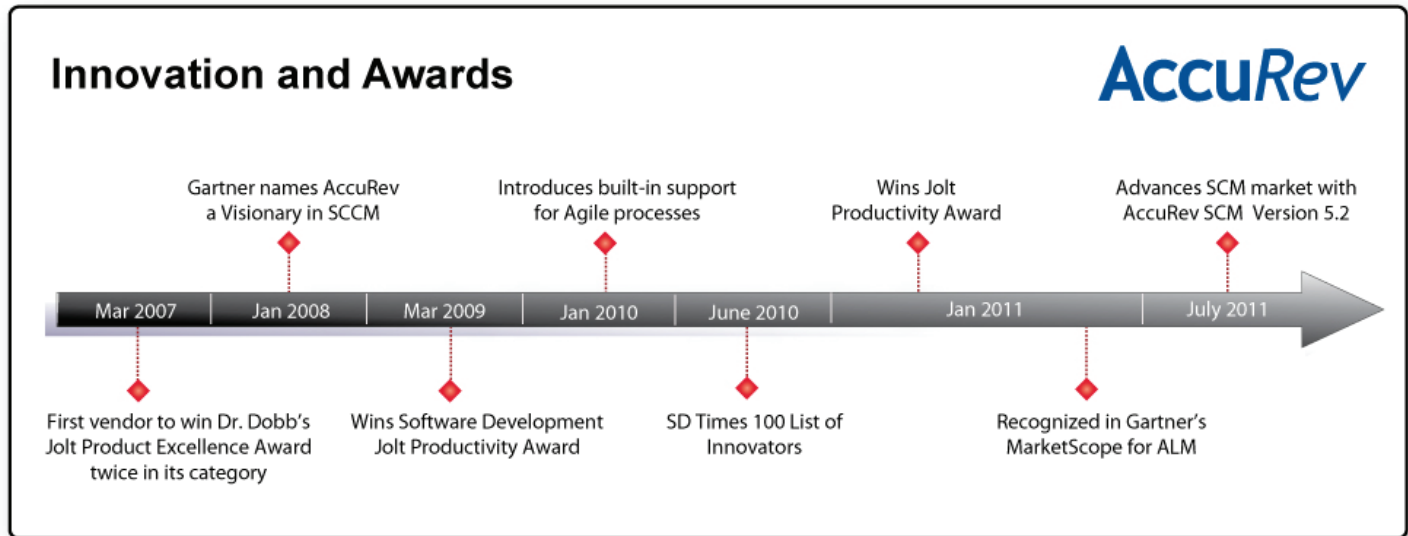
Company History
